Deemed Leading Practice by Accreditation Canada*, CONNECT's Life Redesign Model** is a culture of:

- Personal accountability, support risk taking, social capital and meaningful community participation;
- Services planned around what the person wants more of in life: Participation in relevant life situations drives the residents' goals;
 - Leveraging neuroplasticity by pursuing resident goals in real-life, non-institutional settings; and
 - A "doing-with" coaching approach with blended job roles and a multi-professional coaching team.

Interior's Health Outside-the-Box Request

Interior Health recognized a need for specialized services for people after ABI and stroke to:

- Meet their post-acute rehabilitation needs;
- Reduce dependency on long-term residential care; and
- Connect people back to their communities.

In 2007, Interior Health contracted CONNECT, which lead to the creation of the Life Redesign Model^{III}.

10 years of data reveals significant system savings with CONNECT.


